## FLORIDA CITRUS REGION PCA DRIVERS EDUCATION Rules of Roebling Road

Roebling Road wants you to enjoy your visit, and requires that you observe these rules. Observing these rules and respecting the rights of those in the Roebling Road Raceway community will ensure that everyone has a great time, and will help Roebling Road Raceway maintain Roebling Road's great atmosphere!

- 1. SPEED limit entering the track on neighboring roads is 35 MPH. Speed limit inside the paddock is 5 MPH.
- 2. ALL persons entering Roebling Road Raceway are required to sign the track waiver forms. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 3. NO fireworks, firearms, weapons, or illegal drugs.
- 4. NO ATVs, ATCs, Pit Bikes, Dirt Bikes or Motorized Scooters allowed at any time.
- 5. Please place ALL trash in trash barrels.
- 6. IMPORTANT There are four WASTE FLUID containers:
  - Dump WASTE OIL into 55 gallon drums marked "WASTE OIL".
  - Dump WASTE FUEL into 55 gallon drums marked "WASTE FUEL".
  - Dump COOLANT into 55 gallon drums marked "WASTE COOLANT".
  - Dump BRAKE FLUID into 35-gallon drum located at the FUEL STATION marked "BRAKE FLUID".

Any cross contamination of the above-mentioned fluids will result in a \$1,000.00 fine!

- 7. NO loud music or bass-boomers. All noise should cease at 10:00 PM. Be considerate Roebling Road Raceway's neighbors.
- 8. ANIMALS **MUST** be leashed or tethered at all times. Owners of animals caught roaming **will** be asked to remove them from the paddock area.
- 9. NO ANIMALS are allowed in the buildings at Roebling Road Raceway.
- 10. CAMPFIRES/GROUNDFIRES are not allowed at Roebling Road Raceway.
- 11. DO NOT tape notices to any painted surfaces. It removes the paint. Bulletin boards are provided in restrooms and by results board.
- 12. ABSOLUTELY NO imbedding new brakes and/or testing vehicles on infield roadways.
- 13. NO CROSSING (entrance or exit) allowed while vehicles are on the track.
- 14. NO RACE ENGINES to be RUN BEFORE 8:00 AM OR AFTER 8:00 PM. **\$100.00 FINE FOR VIOLATORS.** If personal cars are being used as transportation to the event, these engines should be turned off as soon as they are parked until 8:00 AM.

## Rules of Roebling Road (Continued)

- 15. NO JUMPING any fences. Violators will be EVICTED!
- 16. DO NOT stand on PIT WALL or APPLY any tape to PIT WALL.
- 17. CHILDREN under 18 are not allowed in RESTRICTED AREAS. This includes HOT PITS and GRIDS.
- 18. TRACK is closed to ALL MOTORIZED vehicles at the end of the day's event. You may walk or bicycle at this time.
- 19. DO NOT damage any grassy area in ANY MANNER.
- 20. DRIVING Counter-race is strictly forbidden at all times.
- 21. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are allowed after the last race of the day. Any use during the races, **will** result in eviction from the track.
- 22. REPORT OIL and FUEL SPILLS to officials so it may get cleaned up. REMEMBER Roebling Road Raceway is under the watchful eye of the EPA.
- 23. EACH Competitor shall have at least (1) portable Dry Chemical Fire Extinguisher with a rating of at least 12 BC available and in good working condition in their pit area.
- 24. DECIBLE LIMITS are set at **103 db**. Roebling Road Raceway will provide a trained sound control technician at your event. If the racer has exceeded the 103-db limits; the racer will be black flagged, brought in, told of the infraction and given a chance to correct the situation. If the racer is not able to correct the noise level, the racer will be required to pull the entered vehicle from the event.
- 25. SUNDAY QUIET TIME In observance of local church services; the track will observe quiet time on Sundays from 11:00 AM to Noon. Absolutely **NO ENGINES** during this time. \$100.00 Fine for Running Engines during this time.
- 26. During an event, it is the Lessee's responsibility to assure the safety and security of the track property for all participants. Lessee assumes responsibility and is subject to being invoiced for damage to the track and its facilities, arising from abuse or misuse of same. Failure to comply with this provision may result in Lessee being required to post a damage bond at future events.
- 27. Lessee is responsible for and will be billed separately for materials and equipment damaged or expended during their event; including but not limited to fire bottles, brooms, speedy dri, guardrails and repairs to track surface.
