PORSCHE SELECTS MONTEREY CAR FESTIVITIES TO UNVEIL NEW PANAMERA IN NORTH AMERICA

Atlanta, July 6, 2009 – Porsche announced it will show its all-new Panamera Gran Turismo to the North American public for the first time during Monterey Peninsula's Classic Car Week (August 9-16) that includes the Quail, a Motorsports Gathering, the Monterey Historics and the famed Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance. The Panamera will go on sale at Porsche's 202 U.S. dealers on October 17, 2009.

To celebrate the arrival of the new Panamera Porsche has joined numerous prestigious brands in sponsoring the Quail, a Motorsports Gathering and the Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance. While the Quail Lodge will be the backdrop of a Porsche Experience Center where VIP test drives will be conducted throughout the week, Pebble Beach has, for the first time, introduced a Porsche category on the hollow grounds of the 18th fairway. The Panamera celebration also involves the 36th Rolex Monterey Historic Automobile Races where Porsche is the featured marque this year. This will have special meaning to all those race drivers, teams, and fans of Porsche as one of the most famous vintage racing events in the world honors the most successful racing brand of all time. Porsche will bring to the event a number of significant and rare historic race cars, the Formula One and Two cars among them.



Stuttgart - 23 June 2009. The vehicles of the Dr. Ing. h.c. F. Porsche AG, Stuttgart, continue to meet the highest quality standards in the USA, the largest export market for the Stuttgart sports car manufacturer. The US market research institute J.D. Power arrived at this conclusion in its latest survey, "Initial Quality Study," which was published yesterday. On July 18th at Limerock Park, **Jörg Bergmeister** won in GT2 for the fourth straight year as he and **Patrick Long** extended their class victory streak to four races. The Flying Lizard Motorsports Porsche 911 GT3 RSR, a new tub since its last race at Utah, won by a lap over Risi Competizione's Jaime Melo and Pierre Kaffer – the reigning Le Mans class winners - in their Ferrari F430 GT.

"I think I'm with the right teams and the right teammates," Bergmeister said of his Lime Rock dominance. "The new car was really performing well. I got in the car with an 18-second lead and tried to maintain that gap.

A NUMBER OF EXPECTED CONTENDERS ENCOUNTERED PROBLEMS AT THE BRUMOS 250 JULY 4TH. **DAVID DONOHUE**, WHO CO-DROVE TO VICTORY IN THE SEASON-OPENING ROLEX 24 AT DAYTONA, WENT TO THE GARAGE AFTER AN ELECTRICAL FIRE IN THE NO. 58 BRUMOS PORSCHE RILEY. THE TEAM REPLACED THE WIRING HARNESS TO ENABLE DONOHUE AND **DARREN LAW** TO SCORE POINTS. **BUDDY RICE** AND **ANTONIO GARCIA**, WHO ALSO SHARED IN THE ROLEX 24 VICTORY, WERE COMPETITIVE IN THE DEBUT RUN OF THE NO. 90 SPIRIT OF DAYTONA PORSCHE COYOTE BEFORE A MECHANICAL MALFUNCTION CAUSED GARCIA TO CRASH IN THE TRI-OVAL ON LAP 36, BRINGING OUT THE SECOND AND FINAL CAUTION.

In GT, Robin Liddell and Andrew Davis in the No. 57 BryanMark Financial/Stevenson Automotive Pontiac GXP.R placed first, breaking a three-race winning streak by point co-leaders **Dirk Werner** and **Leh Keen** in the No. 87 Farnbacher Loles Racing Porsche GT3.

Driver's Education (DE)

One hundred and six drivers turned out for the Citrus/Suncoast Drivers Education held June 27-28. Despite rumors of the surface of the sun being cooler than Sebring, the weather, and temperature, were both pleasant. Saturday evening even featured a legitimate cool breeze. PORSCHE PARADE 2009

The allure of the Rockies and a chance to visit some western friends captured our attention a year ago. Jan and I decided to drive to the Porsche Parade in Keystone, Colorado and make a mini lap of America.

On the first day we drove 12 hours to get a jump start. Then to Rolla, Missouri to visit a Navy buddy I had not seen for over 40 years. From there it was to Casper, Wyoming to visit the Maid of Honor at our wedding. Finally to Keystone and the snow capped mountains, a spectacular destination. If you have good weather, almost anything you do at Keystone or nearby is going to be a success. The mountains are made for scenery and the roads are made for Porsches.

There were 850 registered cars for the event, which, with an active kids program, amounted to probably 1800-1900 people. We had a good turnout from Florida Citrus. Attending were **Jennifer and Greg Barrows, Anne and Bert Del Villano, Norma and Mark Peebles**, new member **David Elliott** and his wife, and **Gary Stratton** stopped by for a short visit.

The first event is always the Concours and it was on a golf course with lake and mountain backdrop. The entries were a bit less than recent Parades at around 100 cars, with a sidebar feature of several Porsche tractors. Next up was the TSD (Time-Speed-Distance) rally. This was a three and a half hour, 100 mile affair that started in Vail. By far the largest class of entrants was the "unequipped" class. You are allowed a regular or stop watch, pencil and paper – no calculators. The route instructions were pretty straight forward, however they changed the required average speed 48 times. There were five hidden checkpoints and you were docked one point for each one hundredth of a minute you were either early or late at the checkpoint compared to the ideal time. They calculated the ideal time from knowing all the distances between speed change points and the required average speed between those points. Each of the five legs was independent so if you were early at one checkpoint that did not offset being late at another. With a little help from the law of compensating errors we put Florida Citrus on the map by finishing first out of 88 cars. We were early or late a total of only 88 seconds among the five checkpoints. It was really competitive with the second place car coming in at 90 seconds. I still am not sure how we did it.

Later in the week they had a gimmick rally in the form of a picture rally taking you through the mountains and some abandoned mining towns. Then it was autocross time with I believe over 300 cars. Mark, Bert and Anne did well in that event. Finally it was the Technical & Historic Quiz where several of us entered, but did not get any top awards. So, after a fun filled week it was back to the long haul days home interspersed with two more visits. Total time 18 days, total miles 4728.

Health Insurance For Your Car

Manufacturer warranties are near the top of most new car shoppers' checklists. This agreement by the manufacturer to handle major repairs for a set amount of time or miles accentuates the peace of mind that comes with being a new-car owner.

But like most good things, manufacturer warranties end, leaving us exposed to budget-breaking repairs.

That's where the extended repair warranty comes in. The premium, usually based on the age and mileage of your vehicle, lets you enjoy continued repair protection. It's like health insurance for your car!

There are plenty of companies offering extended repair warranties. Some good. Some not so good. Even the dealership where you bought your car may offer an extended warranty, but you may be expected to return there for repairs.
