# FLORIDA CITRUS REGION PCA DRIVERS EDUCATION

Track Touring Lap Rules and Procedures

## 1. PARTICIPANTS:

All touring lap participants must have signed the appropriate track and PCA waivers when entering the facility. Any minor (under 18 years of age) participating in this program must have the "PARENTAL CONSENT, RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT FOR TOURING LAPS" waiver completed and signed by their parent or guardian. This waiver is available in the DE section of our website. Please complete this waiver before entering the staging area. All drivers must be 18 years of age or older and have a valid driver's license. Attendance at a DE event and participation in this activity is at the invitation of FLCR and FLCR reserves the absolute right to have any person excluded from participation in this activity or removed from the event premises.

#### 2. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES:

For a vehicle to be eligible to participate in the touring lap session, it must meet the facility's sound restrictions for the scheduled time of the session. Any vehicles either tech'd for the DE event or with a valid state registration will be eligible to participate. Motorcycles, off road vehicles and other extraordinary vehicles will not be permitted to participate in this activity. If in doubt about a particular vehicle, ask for clarification from the Event Chair, Chief Driving Instructor or Safety Chairman prior to the start of the session.

# 3. RESTRAINT SYSTEM:

All participants must utilize a DOT or event approved restraint system. All minors must adhere to applicable local and state mandated child restraint laws.

### 4. SESSION PROCEDURES:

Staging for touring laps will occur on the false grid. The touring lap protocol will consist of a pace car and chase car that maintain safe touring speeds. The pace car will be identified by having its emergency flashers turned on. The pace car will lead the initial group out of pit lane. At a minimum, the two-second rule should be used to determine safe distances between cars. Each driver is responsible for maintaining a safe distance between themselves and the car in front of them. At the same time, drivers must not create excess space between themselves and the car in front of them. There will be no passing during the touring lap session. Drivers can terminate their participation in this activity by entering the pit lane and exiting the track as directed by track control personnel in pit lane. Additionally, participants may enter the pits to switch drivers or exchange passengers. Please pull to the far right of pit lane when switching drivers or exchanging passengers. Again, track control at pit out will direct drivers back out on the course. The checkered flag will indicate that the session is over. Participants on the course are to continue around the track, enter pit lane and exit the track as directed by track control personnel in pit lane.
