Steve Williamson gave a membership report updating the number of current members and associate members which stands at 546 members and 394 affiliates, for a total membership of 940.

The following upcoming events were announced for which the FLC club would participate.

- 1) The Porsche Coral at the Continental Tire series and the Rolex 24 Hour race in Daytona. It was noted that volunteers would be needed for parking and hospitality on the Saturday morning 7:00 till noon. This year the Porsche coral will require a ticket that must be purchased in advanced. The Coral, administered in previous years by our local Porsche clubs, will in the future be more directly overseen by the national PCA office similar to the Sebring 12 hour event and the Coral there. It was also noted there will be garage tours by TRG and a raffle for Hot Pit tours and for hot laps on track.
- 2) The first of the 2013 Autocross events will be help February 9th in Tavares. Everyone was encouraged to sign up in advance at clubregistration.net.
- 3) The winter Drivers Education weekend at Roebling Road on February 16 and 17 and the Instructors day on February 15th prior to the DE. It was pointed out by a number of club members that the web site has not been updated with these new dates and it is still promoting the last October event.
- 4) The Porsche Escape to be held locally in November of 2014.

From the floor a member reminded everyone of the upcoming 48 Hours of Sebring on January 31 –February 3 that will provide both club racing and an advanced DE. It was also noted this event was sold out.
