



Taming the Dragon

Sharp Bends and a Porsche

I took my 2001 Boxster S up to the Smokies in mid-October near Smokey Mountain National Park. There is a great, almost legendary, road there known as The Dragon. It is 11 miles of US 129 with 318 curves that runs through Deals Gap. There are no intersecting driveways, streets, etc., with the exception of one very rustic, dirt, one way road that comes out of the national park and is seldom used. Most of the 11 miles is in Tennessee and the east section in North Carolina ends at the Deals Gap Motorcycle Resort at the intersection of US



129 and NC 28. The resort is very nice and stays busy during "the season" which runs from April to November. They have motel rooms and a campground, restaurant, and gas. I stayed down the road at Fontana Village in a great room for \$59 a night. I have done The Dragon countless times on a motorcycle and a few times in a 911. This was my first time in the Boxster S and despite wet conditions, it was fantastic. There was some brilliant fall color and the weather kept much of the usual traffic away. Wet road with wet leaves on it is a recipe for potential disaster for a motorcycle so bike numbers were down a little. Since The Dragon became more popular in recent years, commercial photograhers have begun to set up shop at various turns and they shoot every vehicle passing by. They then post all of the pictures on their websites for review and purchasing. It was a great time as always and attached are a few pictures. Everybody needs to take their Porsche up there at least once.

Stuttgart. A successful start to the 2010 motorsport year for Porsche: With the Porsche 911 GT3 RSR, works driver Patrick Pilet (France) and Porsche Junior Marco Holzer (Germany), supported by Raymond Narac (France), won the Dubai 24 hour race by a clear margin. For Porsche, this marks the third straight win at the long distance race on the Gulf.



The 911 GT3 RSR fielded by the French IMSA Performance Matmut team turned the 608 laps on the 5.390 kilometre circuit in the Dubai Autodrome without any major mishaps. The most successful GT sports car of the 2009 season, with championship titles in the American Le Mans Series, the Le Mans Series and the FIA GT Championship, took off into the race from pole position to hold the lead for most of the time. Only one heartstopping moment occurred in the first hour, when start driver Patrick Pilet collided whilst lapping a slower competitor, causing some damage to the rear axle of his Porsche. "Initially, we feared it would affect the tyres," the Porsche works driver commented, "but luckily that was not the case. We were still able to attack and turn fast lap times to the finish."

Porsche was by far the most successful manufacturer at the first long distance race of the season: Of the top ten race cars to finish, aside from the winning 911 GT3 RSR, seven were the Porsche 911 GT3 Cup.





PCA Corral at Rolex 24 Hours at Daytona

The green flag will drop on the 48th annual Rolex 24 Hours of Daytona on Jan. 30, 2010 and once again Porsche Club of America members are expected to be there in force. The PCA Parking Corral in the Daytona infield will again welcome PCA members driving Porsches to exclusive parking near one of the most exciting areas on the track.



We also hope to welcome Vic Elford, this year's Grand Marshall, to the PCA corral to share some racing stories. If you have a race ticket which allows infield access, there is no additional charge for parking in the corral. However, parking in the corral is for Porsches only and on a first come basis. Get there early as the corral often fills hours before the race begins. As weather can be unpredictable in late January, a large tent with light refreshments, seating and a closed-circuit TV is available where members can escape from heat, cold, rain or sun and watch a live feed from the track.

This year we hope to offer a Saturday morning opportunity to meet the drivers and tour the track facilities of one of the Porsche teams looking to start the season with a win. In addition, we will have a guided tour of the tech area in the paddock where the track officials inspect each car. Please note that you will need a Paddock upgrade to your standard race ticket or another ticket which offers paddock access to participate in these activities.

Ticket information is available on the Daytona website or at 1-800-Pit-Shop. The corral opens at 8am on Saturday and continues through the end of the race on Sunday afternoon. Camping and fires are strictly prohibited in the PCA Parking corral.

Hardly a month has gone by without an autocross article in the Spiel. Have you ever wondered what autocrosses are all about? Have you ever tried to drive an autocross? If not, please consider joining us for the first event of 2010. The day starts early with setting up the course, emptying your car, and then walking the course. The course is generally laid out in a large lot using highway cones. We divide the drivers into 2 groups, one of which drives while the other administers the course. When it is your turn to drive, you will get a green flag and start off trying to navigate through a series of cone

You can expect to get 6 to 10 timed runs per day, with the possibility of additional fun runs at the end of the competition.




