What is an Autocross?

An Autocross is a lower speed competition event requiring precision and skill as you negotiate a narrow course marked

by orange rubber cones. From tight, low speed turns to short straightaways with speeds reaching 50 or 60 MPH, the action is fast and furious and is designed to exercise the driver more than your Porsche. Quick reflexes and car finesse are the most important requirements. Helmets are required, but loaners are available.



Auto Cross to be held May 16th in Orlando at the Orange County Convention Center

May Autocross in Orlando!

First Auto Cross at the Orange County Convention Center

We promise a fun day with lots of time to develop your driving skills, and just as importantly, to enjoy a good time with fellow Porsche enthusiasts.

The day starts early with setting up the course, emptying your car, and then walking the course. The course is generally laid out in a large lot using highway cones. We divide the drivers into 2 groups, one of which drives while the other administers the course. When it is your turn to drive, you will get a green flag and start off trying to navigate through a series of cone gates. Initially, some see the course as a meaningless sea of cones, but with the help of our experienced driver/instructors, the sea eventually parts yielding a challenging set of turns, slaloms, and short straights. Each driver runs the course one at a time and gets a time at the end of his lap. Drivers are ranked by class, then by time and awarded points for the year end competition. You can expect to get 6 to 10 timed runs per day, with the possibility of additional fun runs at the end of the competition.

I was running around like crazy at the race (it was my first real "full" race, so I don't yet know exactly what I'm supposed to be doing!) so I didn't take any pictures myself, just what friends have taken. These are the two best ones I found. One is of Greg's enduro pitstop. I'm refueling, and Darren Deguire is helping Greg get into the car. The second photo is of my #94 on pole position for GTC3 class. It's my first pole position!

I don't know exactly what format you want, or how much space you have to work with, so I'll try and give you some tidbits that you can arrange as you please. Road Atlanta is one of the biggest PCA races of the year, and we had competitors



from CA and Canada. We had a beautiful sunny day for the sprint races Saturday, and rain for the enduro's Sunday.

I placed first in both of my races. It was my first real "start" for a race, so I was wide eyed coming down the hill, at speed, into turn 1, with all the other cars seemingly inches away from me! I definitely erred on the side of caution for the first few practice starts, as it was super intimidating. I didn't know how to approach qualifying either, so I ended up following people instead of gapping myself to get a clean lap. Because of that, I started further back in my first race, and had to drive like mad to get around those in my class that were in front of me. I had no idea of my position until the end of the race because of all the commotion of being in the thick of things! For the second race, I got to start on the pole because I had won the first race, and somehow stayed in front for the win!

I know that Greg came in 2nd in his class for both of his races, but I don't know the results for the others. I think Mark finished further down. I don't know how Darren Deguire (J class 993 twin turbo), or Casey did either.

Our next race is VIR in June, and hopefully I'll have my wits more about me, and take photos this time!

Second Porsche win in a row – 911 GT3 R Hybrid on podium

Porsche Press Release - Stuttgart. The Porsche 911 has again underlined its supremacy as the world's most successful GT race car: At the second race of the Nürburgring Long Distance Championship, the new Porsche 911 GT3 R celebrated its second straight win. The innovative 911 GT3 R Hybrid, which features two electric motors supplementing the combustion engine in the rear, finished third. Seven Porsche 911 were amongst the top ten finishers.

In a repeat of the season-opening race, the yellow-green Porsche 911 GT3 R fielded by Manthey Racing ran without any technical

problems from start to finish. The result for the driver trio Timo Bernhard (Germany), Romain Dumas (France) and Marcel Tiemann (Monaco): Win number two of the season.

Works drivers Joerg Bergmeister and Wolf Henzler (both Germany) drove an entirely trouble free race in the new Porsche 911 GT3 R Hybrid. The hybrid vehicle impressed with outstanding efficiency and needed one less pit stop than most competitors. "The hybrid system clearly helped us to save fuel. Moreover, it's a great feeling to have those extra 120 kW from the electric motors when you accelerate out of the corners," describes Joerg Bergmeister.

Mamerow Racing's Porsche 911 GT3 R with drivers Chris Mamerow and Sascha Bert (both Germany) also put in an excellent drive until they were sidelined by an accident while running second.

Porsche claims class win with best overall efficiency

Porsche Press Release - Stuttgart. Again at the second round of the American Le Mans Series, the Porsche 911 GT3 RSR was the vehicle with the best overall efficiency. On the street circuit in California's Long Beach, title defenders Joerg Bergmeister (Germany) and Patrick Long (USA) celebrated their first victory in the GT class this season with the sports car from Weissach and won the environmental award, the Michelin Green X Challenge. The Porsche RS Spyder was the vehicle with the best combination of performance and energy efficiency in the sports prototype LMP class.

"The key to our success was our sensational pit stop. It put us within striking distance of the front-runners, even though we had to fit four new tyres while the leading BMW had only changed their driver at this time," said Joerg Bergmeister. The winner from last year drove a tactically clever race and kept out of any scuffles on the narrow track edged by walls and fences. Bergmeister handed the Flying Lizard Motorsports 911 GT3 RSR over to his works driver colleague Patrick Long who, with a spirited effort, then snatched the lead and held on to it until the chequered flag of the 100 minute race came out. Joerg Bergmeister said: "Patrick put our competitors under huge pressure and made them pay for not putting on new tyres earlier." With this win, the title defenders now lead the points.


