

Club member David Edwards was recently featured in the Dental Society of Greater Orlando's magazine. We have reprinted it below for all of our members to enjoy as well.

Dr. David Edwards: The Driving Dentist

Interviewed by Dr. Jim Flatley

lthough most of us enjoy practicing dentistry, it would be odd to say that there is ever "visceral excitement" involved in a day at the office. So, Dr. David Edwards has turned to racing with the Porsche Club of America (PCA) for his visceral excitement. Other local dentists who have gotten the bug are John Beattie, John Cordoba, Ofilio Morales, Mark Dreyer, and Mike Layton. Dave owns an actual Porsche race car, while the other guys race their street-legal cars on weekends but also drive the same cars to work during the week.

Dave started racing go-karts while in dental school. They go about 70mph, sit about an inch off the ground, and feel like a rocket ship. Most professional race car drivers spend a considerable amount of time training in karts, so he followed that path. Fellow DSGO member Chad Wright also raced the karts with him at UE.

Now, most of his track time is spent racing Porsches but he also enjoys instructing others with the Porsche and Ferrari clubs. His experience and expertise has given him the opportunity to drive cars that most people only see in magazines.

SAYS DR. EDWARDS:

My father taught me to remodel houses and how to rebuild old cars. In elementary and middle school I raced remote control cars with him and also raced in our local Soap Box Derby. Dad's influence was critical in my racing progression because I was always able to prepare and fix my own equipment.

In high school I sold cars for a local car dealer and was eventually charged with selling all of the Corvettes and a variety of other sports cars. As a perk, I got to drive them until they sold, and I was allowed to start autocrossing them. Autocross is a makeshift road course set up in a convention-center-sized parking lot, where you race against the clock, while staying between the cones that are positioned on the course.

I continued car-dealing through college. Eventually, I bought the black car and started doing drivers education events (De's), which are weekend-long events where you can drive as fast as you want at big tracks like Sebring and Daytona. They're very social, and generally involve a fun and relaxed atmosphere. They're not competitive, and have a strong emphasis on safety and performance driving. They achieve that by being very orga-

nized and well-controlled; and novices can learn to drive with instructors by their sides the whole time. I followed this progression, working my way up to being an instructor in college, and have done it ever since.

After finishing dental school, I sold the black car and bought the blue car, and began racing wheel-to-wheel, competitively. It's a big rush, running at high speeds - inches from each other. It's a very competitive and precise sport. The blue car is a factory-built race car. It is high-powered, very light; and has lots of carbon fiber body panels, gummy slick tires, and runs on racing gas. It's the fastest and most entertaining car I've ever driven...and racing it is absolutely exhilarating!

The PCA has a great overall ladder system starting with autocross, DEs, and finally club racing - that gradual progression takes a lot of the intimidation out of just stepping out onto a racetrack. DE's are the sweetspot of the three in terms of commitment, intensity, and fun.

Dave says that he's met a lot of really interesting people in an environment where everyone is really passionate about being there. Take it from him: "If you like sports cars, and like to go fast, give it a try. I can promise that you'll love it!"



2014 TUDOR United SportsCar Championship Series

GRAND AM has announced the 2014 TUDOR United SportsCar Championship Series schedule. There will be 12 races this year. All the venues except Long Beach have had either an ALMS Porscheplatz or GRAND AM Car Corral. IMSA will be the sanctioning body. The series, as noted above, will be titled the TUDOR United SportsCar Championship Series. TUDOR is a premium Swiss watchmaking brand and a subsidiary of Rolex. In addition to being the Entitlement Partner of the TUDOR United SportsCar Championship, TUDOR is also currently the World Timing Partner for both Ducati and the FIA World Endurance Championship. The only event in which TUDOR will not be the title sponsor is the Rolex 24 Hours of Daytona.

GRAND AM had many interested parties but for 2014, they only considered facilities from their 2013 Rolex Series and ALMS schedules. The 2014 lineup features four race tracks currently on the Rolex Series schedule, four that are on the current ALMS schedule and four that were on both series' 2013 schedules.

There will also be two test sessions November 16-17, 2013 at Sebring International Raceway and November 19-20 at Daytona International Speedway. The test sessions will be open to all four classes of cars that will compete in the new championship: Prototype, Prototype Challenge, GT Le Mans and GT Daytona. Session schedules will be announced in the near future.

The 2014 TUDOR United SportsCar Championship schedule is as follows: The dates are race days only.

- Jan. 25-26: Daytona International Speedway
- o The 52nd running of the Rolex 24 will be the debut event for the new championship series.
- March 15 Sebring International Raceway
- o The Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring fueled by Fresh From Florida. The 62nd race, North America's oldest sports car race will part of the same series and under the same sanctioning body as Daytona for the first time since 1998.
- April 12 Long Beach
- o This will be a street race again in conjunction with IZOD IndyCar Series. ... Prototype and GT Le Mans classes will compete together. This is on the schedule because Southern California is one of the most important consumer markets for nearly all TUDOR United SportsCar Championship stakeholders.
- May 4 Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca
- May 31: Detroit Belle Isle

o Also a companion street-race event to IndyCar. This race will feature the Prototype, Prototype Challenge and GT Daytona classes. This event is on the schedule Detroit is home to many of the auto manufacturers partici-

pating in the TUDOR United SportsCar Championship plus numerous supplier partners.

- June 29: Watkins Glen International o The track is owned by NASCAR
- July 13: Canadian Tire Motorsport Park
- July 25: Indianapolis Motor Speedway
 This again will be a co-hosted event with the NASCAR Sprint Cup series
- Aug. 10: Road America
- August 24: Virginia International Raceway o Event will have a combined GT Le Mans/GT Daytona race and another race featuring the Prototype Challenge class.
- Sept. 20: Circuit of the Americas

Steve Williamson asked for reports of recent events and if there were any additional comments or announcements.


Lyn Perez gave a recap of the recent Drive and Dine event to Deals Gap and regions NC with the Crown Club where Citrus region has 8 cars participate.


