Enjoy your Porsche and I look forward to seeing vou soon!



(If You Have The Right Tools and Plenty of Patience)!





Before



I had always been frustrated with stock seat belts not providing the support I needed running at our DE's at Roebling Road. And despite my 996 C4S having sport seats, they too didn't quite hold me securely enough where I felt part of the car, not just an object rolling to the whims of centrifugal force. Talking with fellow clubber and Troysport owner Sid Collins,

we discussed the options for seats, belts and rollbars. Unfortunately, the costs kept me from leaping for a couple of years.

Finally realizing that I wasn't getting any younger I decided to take the plunge but would do the installations myself. So after adding a few "stylin" updates to the shopping list, PayPal and I got on a first name basis. Porsche racing seats (pca.org) with painted belt pass throughs (Ross Evers), a DAS roll/harness bar (dassport.com), RaceQuip seatbelts (Sid Collins), new Guards Red console, dash horseshoe and trim piec-

es (bumperplugs.com), new pedals and floor mats, windshield logo (suncoastparts.com) and Momo steering wheel and hub adapter (andysautosport. com) were purchased. That was the easy part!

Disassembly of the interior was fairly straightforward but never would have been successful without advice from Porsche blogs and other websites. The advice and stories varied but helpful videos were aplenty and saved the day. I also took my own videos along the way in case "restoring to original" was ever contemplated. Rear seat and rear speaker removal to get to the strut towers was simple but front seat removal was not so easy. Lots of connectors to deal with and the stock seats were twice the weight of the GT3 racing seats. But after viewing more on-line videos, the seats came out. Couldn't believe that I next found myself with a drill in my hand attacking the trim pieces on the dash! But again, more on-line help got it done despite a little damage disassembling the speedo/

tach cluster. The first attempt at putting the rollbar in didn't pan out because it didn't fit my car. After I ordered a replacement from DAS, UPS lost it but another arrived a week later. The DAS roll/harness bar comes unpainted but a couple cans of Valspar satin black did a pretty good job. And fortunately, the bar comes in 2 pieces, otherwise it would have been a nightmare to install as several of the videos I watched attested to. Once the bar was in I remounted the new red console and reassembled the dash. Then the seats went in and finally the seat belts and carpets. Only the Momo wheel to go before Scarlett (the C4S) and I head to Roebling for the Crown DE on April 21 and 22.

The tools that were absolutely critical (besides the internet) to all the work included a set of TORX bits and screwdrivers, Macarbon installation tools, socket wrenches and extensions, torque wrench, tie wraps, etc., etc. And the patience? I have little but decided it was going to take as long as it took and that worked. Also, I have a feeling that the Gemini astronauts would think their capsule was the Taj Mahal compared to working inside a stripped 911 cockpit. 

As a new member of PCA, it's probably a bit intimidating when you get started. I know it was for me. You just bought your "first" Porsche (yes, there will be many more!). Or you finally joined PCA, after a while of owning. But now what? You think, "OK, I'm at my first club meeting. The people seem nice enough ... but now that the meeting's over, what do I do?" And what's this DE thing they keep talking about? And why does Porsche have its own Parade? Aren't the cars flashy enough - do they really need a parade too? Hmmm, maybe I should have bought a Corvette. Kidding, of course – nothing beats owning, driving and racing a Porsche! You'll see ...

Buying your car is just the first marker on the long road of fun that lies ahead of you. If you're good enough (or sometimes, maybe just rich, so I've heard!), you can race your car on some of the best tracks in the world. Yes, race – potentially with your own race team (that's where the rich part comes in). Who knew?! I certainly didn't. I'd always wanted a Porsche and was so thrilled to be lucky enough to finally own one. But then, I found out about this ridiculously fun and exciting world of Porsche. You could do an event every week of the year if you wanted. It's your choice (well, and maybe your spouse will have a say too).

The easiest way to navigate your way through all the lingo, events, technical aspects, and Porscheisms is to

volunteer at an event. Really, it is. And yes, we could use your help as well! You'll immediately start learning fun and interesting things, and everyone will help you out along the way – you will not be alone. Best of all, you don't have to fear messing up, since they won't really give you any activities that you could screw up. Baby steps!

Now that you have your new toy, here are a few of the fun things you can start planning to do:

Driver's Education: That's the "DE" thing they were talking about! DEs are held every month (sometimes, every week) on some of the best tracks in the southeast (or, the country, if you choose). You can drive on tracks such as Sebring, Daytona and Homestead, plus our "home" track in Savannah, Roebling Road. You'll learn driving skills that you didn't even know existed. When our club has driving events (and some of the social events), you'll register at www.clubregistration.net. It's easy to set up an account – instructions are posted on our website (flc.pca.org). Our club has a few events a year, but you can attend other club's events too. Most of the PCA events are posted at ClubRegistration. But there are other non-Porsche centric driving events through other clubs as well, such as Chin Motorsports or NASA (no, not that one; it's the National Auto Sport Association). If you get addicted enough and have the time (and money), you'll be doing all of this.

When you start doing DEs, you'll be in the "Green" (novice) group. You'll start out with classroom time and when it's time to drive, an instructor will ride along with you, instructing you all along the way. As you progress, you'll eventually be able to drive solo. But learn all that you can at first. You really don't know everything, no matter what you may think. You'll learn a lot about the technicalities of driving, as well as about your car's handling and engineering. You'll be a much better driver on the regular road, much less on the track. The end goal is to learn all the parameters of the track, including entry points, apexes, exits, brake points, acceleration, and more. After you learn all this, it will help you get around the track safely and quickly. But in the meantime, you can just enjoy learning everything you can on the track and become a really good "point by-er," like me. The "point by" is the signal you give another car, so they know they can pass you on the straight. Personally, I'm really good at that part: "No, please, after you!"

Autocross: FLC offers a free autocross enrollment to new PCA members at their first monthly meeting – to entice you to get your feet wet. At my first meeting, I thought, "Great, it's free. But what exactly is an autocross - is it a slalom course kind of thing?" Well, it sort of is. I just did my first AX (see, there's another acronym that you now know!), and it was so much fun. They're usually held on large parking lots, with orange traffic cones set out as the course markers. Try not to hit those! You'll walk the course to begin with, to get used to all the turns. And you can have an instructor ride with you, if you'd like. I recommend that, because it's not as easy as it sounds, at first. For my first AX, I learned even more about my car's handling, braking and steering. I also learned that your hands actually can get in the way of each other when you're in such tight turns! Again, who knew?! Your runs are timed, so you can see your progress with each subsequent run. AX teaches you a lot about driving and your car's limits, in a safe, comfortable, slow-speed environment. And it's just so darn much fun!

Social events: There are many of these throughout the year, so plan to attend as many as you can. And volunteer to help, please! They range from chili cookoffs and Saturday morning meet-ups, to charity rallies, car shows and road trips. And we go to dinner after each monthly meeting, so that's a great way to get to know some of your fellow PCA members.






