
All in all, it was a picture-perfect day filled with great cars, great roads, and even better company. Can't wait for the next one! ■

In mid-March, I sat down with Mike Colon near his home in Longwood to get to know him a little better.

Mike is a long-time member of the FLC region of the PCA. He is a kind-hearted, gentle soul with a wonderful sense of humor. If you've not already gotten to know this man, you'll find that he has a wealth of information, knowledge, and is a good listener. He's the kind of person who is a calming force when life is crazy and I am happy to call him 'friend.' We were able to visit in his enviable mancave, recently built by Keith Williams with Swift Construction and Remodel company.

It is here that he stores friends' Porsches. The space is quite large and comfy and is so new that he has yet to put his Porsche memorabilia and pictures up on the wall.

## How long have you been with the Florida Citrus Region PCA?

**Mike Colon:** I've been with the FLC PCA on and off since the late nineties, since '97 or '98. It was when I started tracking. I've been a Porsche owner since right around '88 or '89. It took 10 years of Porsche ownership to join the club... Once I started tracking, I went to my first tech session. Then I decided to become a member.

#### How many Porsches have you owned?

**MC:** Personal cars? Probably around twenty. Flipping cars, buying and selling cars... I've been in and out of that business for many years, but probably over a hundred Porches there.

#### What would be your favorite Porsche and why?

MC: 930, late 80's, mostly because of all the posters I saw as a child with a big, wide, politically correct saying: 'rear end!' Of course, they were one of the fastest Porsches available at the time- the 930 Turbo! [He has had three-








black and red. The last one was red and he totaled it, having added too much power.] It's called a "widow-maker" for a reason!" [He was on I-4 on his way to The 12 hours at Sebring and gave it too much gas at the wrong time. It spun and flipped... several times.]

## What was going through your mind?

MC: "This isn't going to end well!"

## That's it? No profanity?

**MC:** No! I was turning around in a circle and finally rolled it. I did quite a bit of damage.

## Did it damage you, too?

MC: My shoulders were hurt a little bit from holding the

steering wheel while the car was rolling. I was holding my torso and steering the wheel. It did do quite a bit of damage to my shoulders. But I recovered!

### Do you have a dream Porsche? If so, which one?

**MC:** A GT3RS would be up there but a dream one would be a Ruf Turbo from that same era.

## Is this a dream that might one day become a reality?

MC: It's a possibility!

#### Electric cars - a great thing or not such a great thing?

**MC:** Not a fan! It's more politicized than it should be. Also not obtainable with the charging stations and such. [He would not buy one but might lease one as they go down in value. Most tracks don't allow them on-track.]

## What is your favorite Citrus Region activity?

**MC:** The drives! Going to lunch together and being social. [He loves driving up to North Carolina mountains. One memorable trip was going to Virginia and VIR with the group.] I like trailering my car and driving a motorcycle up there too.

## How would you like to see the Citrus region PCA grow and develop?

**MC:** I'm happy with what the club is doing lately. Karyn is doing a great job.

#### What was or is your current employment title?

MC: Entrepreneur!

## Do you think that your career has influenced the way you drive or see the world?

MC: It's the other way around! How I saw the world was how I chose my latest career. By being involved with Porsches and the issues that I've had in the past with servicing, etc. That's why I decided to get involved in the repair of Porsches. Being more involved with the track stuff and being more involved with modifying cars, etcetera.

## Throughout your life and career who has been the most inspirational to you and why?

MC: There are many people that have been inspirational. Lyn Perez has been there whenever I needed an ear to bounce ideas and has gone the extra mile to help me in any way possible. Another person I would mention is Linda, who has put up with my madness in buying and selling... She hasn't given me a hard time about anything that I've been involved in. I've had so many influences throughout the years– coaches, techs that I've been involved with, all have been great. Mostly all good experiences.

#### Where is your favorite place to take your Porsche?

**MC:** The Mountains! The Carolina Mountains. Specifically the Tail of the Dragon in the Blue Ridge Mountains.

## What would you like to be most remembered for, both in the PCA and in the rest of your life?

**MC:** Personality and integrity. Always being in a good mood, happy, and smiling- hopefully- and integrity. Integrity is real important to me. Just the way that I was raised. Always being honest, upfront, and truthful.

## Bonus Question! When you go on the track, describe the sensations that you are experiencing and what thoughts are going through your mind?

MC: I've been attending over twenty-five years of HPDE [High Performance Driving Education]. My first thought before arriving at the track is "Why am I doing this?" My nerves are on high-alert! Since the beginning of my tracking days, I have been- and still am- extremely nervous about damaging my car, for potential devaluing, and any other "what-if" situations. Through the decades I've experienced many different phases of tracking... from being a beginner who thought I wanted to become a racecar driver, to becoming a coach.

But it's about the people and not so much the driving. The one constant in HPDE is the great people that are involved. From the staff to the participants, I have gained a family. It is hard for me to describe how PCA has impacted my life and influenced my career choice for the last 15 years. I am extremely grateful.

#### SONNENFEST "77"

May 27th saw about 14 of us on our way down to Sebring in a rain storm, none of us will soon forget.

We all enjoyed Friday nights festivities, in the form of a beer bust. Some of us a little more "BUSTED", then others. I'm not sure if Dave and Maggie will ever want another midnight pizza.

Saturday morning saw all of us who were going to Concours in tears, trying to undo the damage the rain had done to our beautifully polished cars. What a mess!

That afternoon during judging, what do you suppose happened? You're right, it rained. With a little patience however, the sun did return, and the judging did finish in the steam.

Later that same afternoon, all the Rallye enthusiasts were lined up and ready to go when what do you suppose we began to feel? Right, again RAIN, RAIN, RAIN. This time it wasn't just a spring shower but a real gully washer. We continued on our way determined not to give way to the elements.
